Arizona Balance & Hearing Associates (ABHA) was established in January 2004 by Managing Member Dana Day, AuD, MBA and Medical Director Terry D. Fife, M.D. Before January 2004, ABHA operated as an Outpatient Balance and Hearing Center on the campus of St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center since 1995.

Well established in the valley and in the southwest ABHA offers clinical services in vestibular testing, pediatrics, and neurodiagnostics. We have three (3) ASHA certified audiologists on site and our Medical Director, Terry Fife; M.D. located in the office adjacent to our facility.
